PART riders are welcome to come enjoy Pottstown's Town Center. As the main hub for the transit buses, the addition of the Charles W. Dickinson Transportation Center to the Town Center has brought many new visitors. Dedicated in February 2011, the Transit Center offers passengers a comfortable alternative with a view of the well designed Smith Family Plaza. Smith Family Plaza is the site of many events held in Pottstown.

The National Register of Historic Districts lists the area now known as the Town Center-including the site of the old Pottstown Rail Station. Not only is this site lovely, well maintained, and decorated seasonally with flowers by PART, but it is rich in history. The newest addition to the Transit Center is a beautiful timepiece donated by the World War II Dance Committee and PART in remembrance of soldiers who once used the train platform to depart for war. Riders of Pottstown Area Rapid Transit are invited to watch for more exciting changes coming to the Transportation Center including the addition of a new PART kiosk.
