RE: Report to Borough Council – March '09

Dear Councilors:

The following information is provided as a means to give each of you a glimpse at some of the activities that the members of the Pottstown Police Department were involved in during the past month. Although the information presented is not intended to be all-inclusive; it is my intent that after your review, you will have a better understanding of the day-to-day work being performed by the men and women of your Police Department. Further; it is my hope that these monthly reports will provide each of you with some insight into the high level of professional services provided by the police officers in our community.

The following information is provided as informational and does not represent all of the activities that department members engaged/participated in during the month of March 2009.

- 1) Members of the Pottstown Police Department responded to a total of 1,807 calls for service. Although the following list is not totally inclusive; Pottstown officers:
 - a) investigated 106 Part I crimes;
 - b) investigated 265 Part II crimes(at least 96 of which were officer initiated);
 - c) made 109 misdemeanor & felony arrests;
 - d) made 116 summary violation (non-traffic) arrests;
 - e) executed 13 search warrants;
 - f) served 29 arrest warrants;
 - g) conducted 38 drug investigations
 - h) investigated 9 run-away youth complaints;
 - i) investigated 191 reported disturbances;
 - j) dealt with 9 abandoned vehicles;
 - k) responded to 110 domestic disturbances;
 - l) made 6 curfew violation arrests;
 - m) responded to 67 false burglary/hold-up alarms;
 - n) investigated 70 traffic crashes;
 - o) investigated 84 parking complaints
 - p) issued 138 parking citations;
 - q) made 13 DUI arrests;
 - r) issued 193 traffic citations;
 - s) during this time period several hundred follow-up investigations were conducted by our members;
 - t) members attended 123 traffic & criminal hearings at the local Magisterial District Courts as well as 5 criminal trials at the Court of Common Pleas in Norristown, 3 Juvenile Court hearings, and 1 mental health hearings at Norristown State hospital, and lastly;
 - u) we housed 179 prisoners in our cells (70 of whom were from outside agencies).

- 2) Members of the Pottstown Police Department were involved in the following community service/public relations initiatives:
 - a) D.A.R.E. Education continues at five (5) Borough Elementary Schools (5 public, 2 private);
 - b) Police Ride-Along Program/College Interns spent a total of 36 hours with us during the month;
 - c) Cops 'n Kids Reading Program at the YWCA & Salvation Army, and;
 - d) Planning work continues in regard to the PPD 2009 Bike Rodeo to be held on June 13th at Memorial Park.
 - e) Planning, in coordination with the PPOA, continues in regard to the upcoming PPOA Fishing Derby, for children 12 years of age & younger, to be held at Memorial Park (on the Island) from 8 AM to 12 Noon on Saturday May 30th.

- 3) Members attended/participated in the following training:
 - a) 2009 MPOETC Mandatory Update training continued for all members (will continue through April);
 - b) Mandatory firearms training/re-qualification continued for all members;
 - c) (5) members attended the PA Coordinator's Conference Re-Trainer at State College (expenses paid by PA DOT);
 - d) PPD CMERT Officers participated in regularly scheduled tactical and/or negotiations training;
 - e) PPD K9 Officers participated in skills maintenance training, and;
 - f) (2) members attended Pepper Ball (a defensive weapons system) Instructor/Armorer training at Bethlehem, PA P.D.
- 4) The Department Administration conducted follow-up on three (3) outstanding internal investigations, and closed-out one (1) internal investigation.
- 5) The Department Administration conducted policy review on two (2) Departmental General Orders, continued the update process on two (2) Departmental General Orders, and worked on the continued development of two (2) new Departmental General Orders.
- 6) The Department Administration continues to follow-up with the in-progress comprehensive traffic study for the area in and around Charlotte St. & Jefferson Ave. It is anticipated that we will be able to report findings and provide recommendations at June Council Meeting.
- 7) Our Department Administrative Manager continues to extrapolate requested data for Management Partners as part of the study process. So far approximately seventy (70) hours have been spent on the project – this is being done in addition to the DAM's regular duties.
- 8) The first of several "Warrant Sweeps" was conducted throughout the region on March 25th. This sweep was a cooperative endeavor between the Pottstown, Upper Pottsgrove, West Pottsgrove, Lower Pottsgrove Police Departments, the two local Magisterial District Court Judges, and the local PA State Constables. During the first sweep forty (40) went before the District Court Judges. Since that time more have turned themselves in. Two more "Warrant Sweeps" have been scheduled for May and June.
- 9) The Pottstown Police Department Community Partnership hosted a community meeting on March 24th at the Pottstown Area Police Athletic League (PAL) office located at 146 King St. The meeting was well attended and a great deal of information was shared. The next regular meeting of the Pottstown Police Department Community Partnership is scheduled for Wednesday April 29th in the Pottstown Police Department Training Room.

- 10) Wave #1 of the PA DOT Seatbelt and Smooth Operator Programs ended in March. The Seatbelt and Smooth Operator programs are fully funded by PA DOT and are designed to address and/or deter aggressive driving and vehicle occupant injuries throughout PA. Our region is comprised of Pottstown and nine (9) of our surrounding Montgomery County municipalities. Our Region logged 669.75 hours (Pottstown = 132) during Wave #1; conducted 1,522 vehicle stops (Pottstown = 327); and issued 1,400 traffic citations (Pottstown = 219). Wave #2 will commence in the next few weeks.

- 11) Over a fifteen (15) day period in March; Pottstown Officers conducted traffic safety operations as a part of, and funded through the PA DOT Community of Opportunities Seatbelt Grant. During these operations; sixty-eight (68) traffic citations were issued (five for seatbelt violations) and officers made two (2) DUI and two (two) drug violation arrests.

During April 2009 the Pottstown Police Department answered 1,834 calls for service. Of these calls 1,826 occurred in the Borough.

During the month we averaged 61.13 calls per day or 30.57 calls per 12 hour shift. For the year we have answered 6,926 calls. The daily average for the year is 57.72 calls per day or 28.86 calls per 12 hour shift.

During April 2008 we answered 2,030 calls. We answered 196 fewer calls this month than last April. This is a decrease of 9.66% from last year. For the year we have answered 215 fewer calls than this time in 2008. This is an decrease of 3.01%.

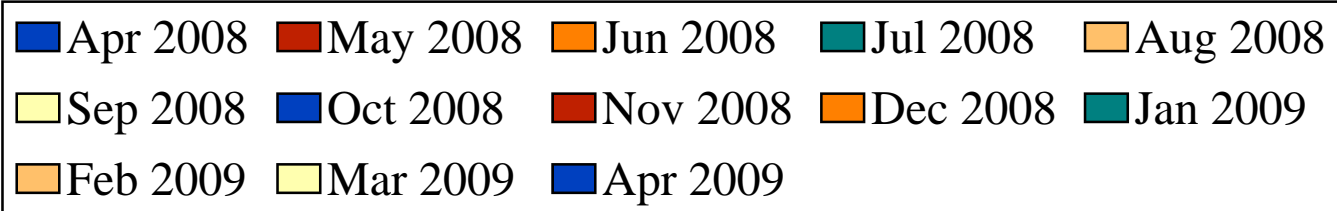
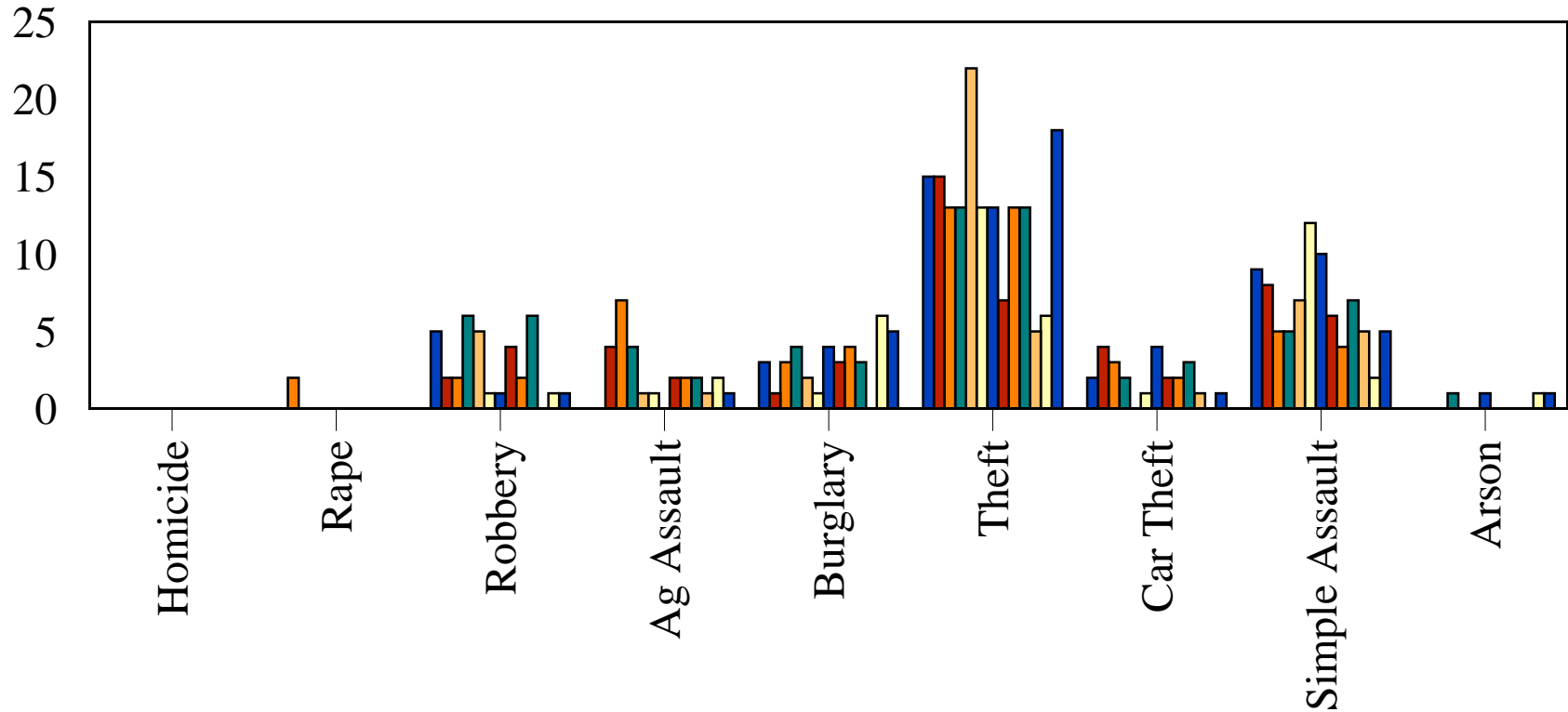

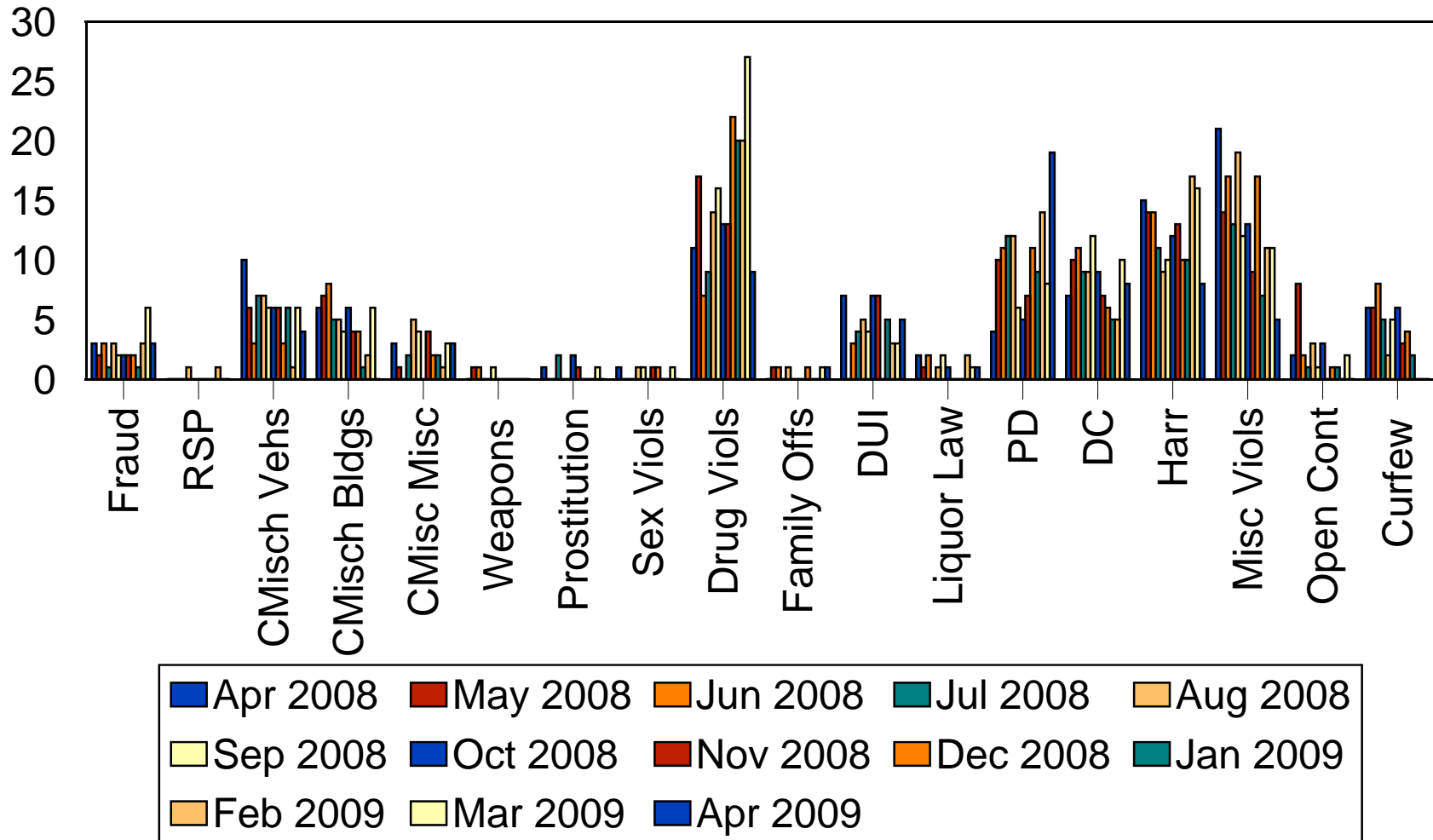

Part 1 Crimes - 12 Month Comparison



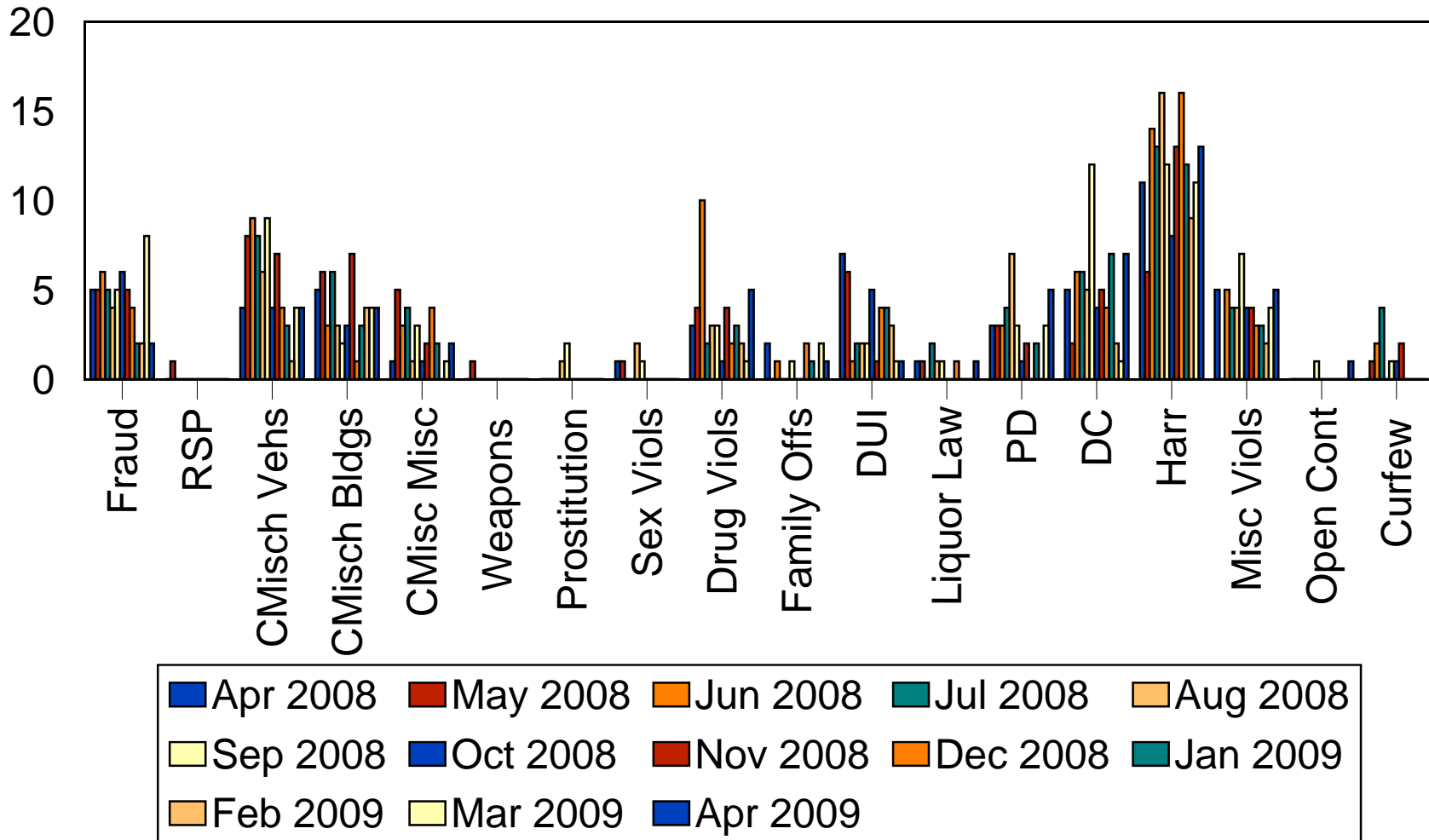
